



MAKE A MATARIKI STAR

1. Print out template either double sided or single. Cut out the star along the lines.
2. Fold in all three points of the triangle to the other side.
3. Open your star and turn it over. Fold the three small "designed" triangles part triangle back and leave folded down.
4. Turn the star, which should now resemble a hexagon, back to the first side.
5. Fold down the big triangles again. This time they now have little triangles coming down with them from the other side.
6. These triangles should be overlapping. Take the top layer, and tuck the corner under the corner of the bottom layer, so each layer has one corner on top of another.

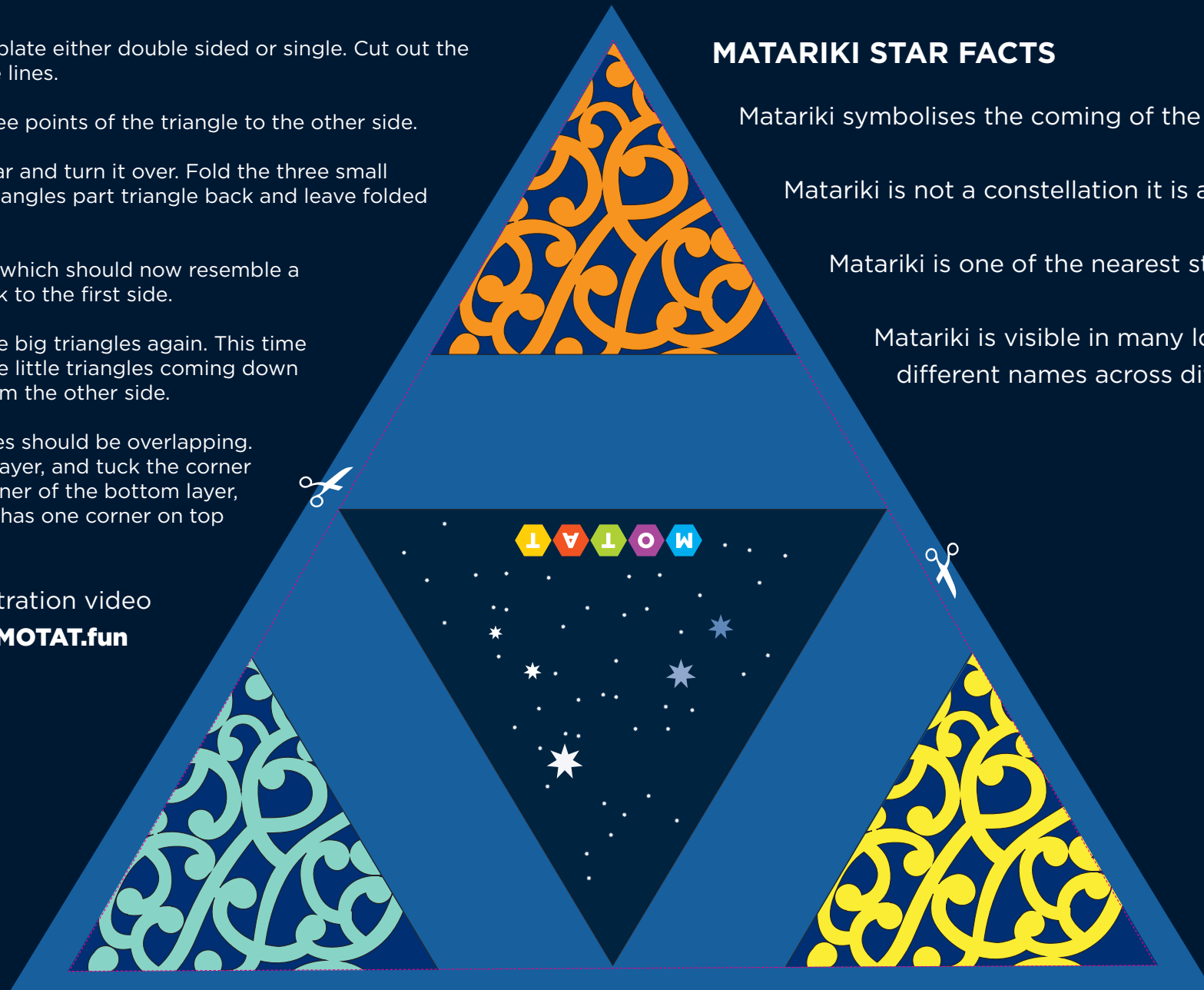
MATARIKI STAR FACTS

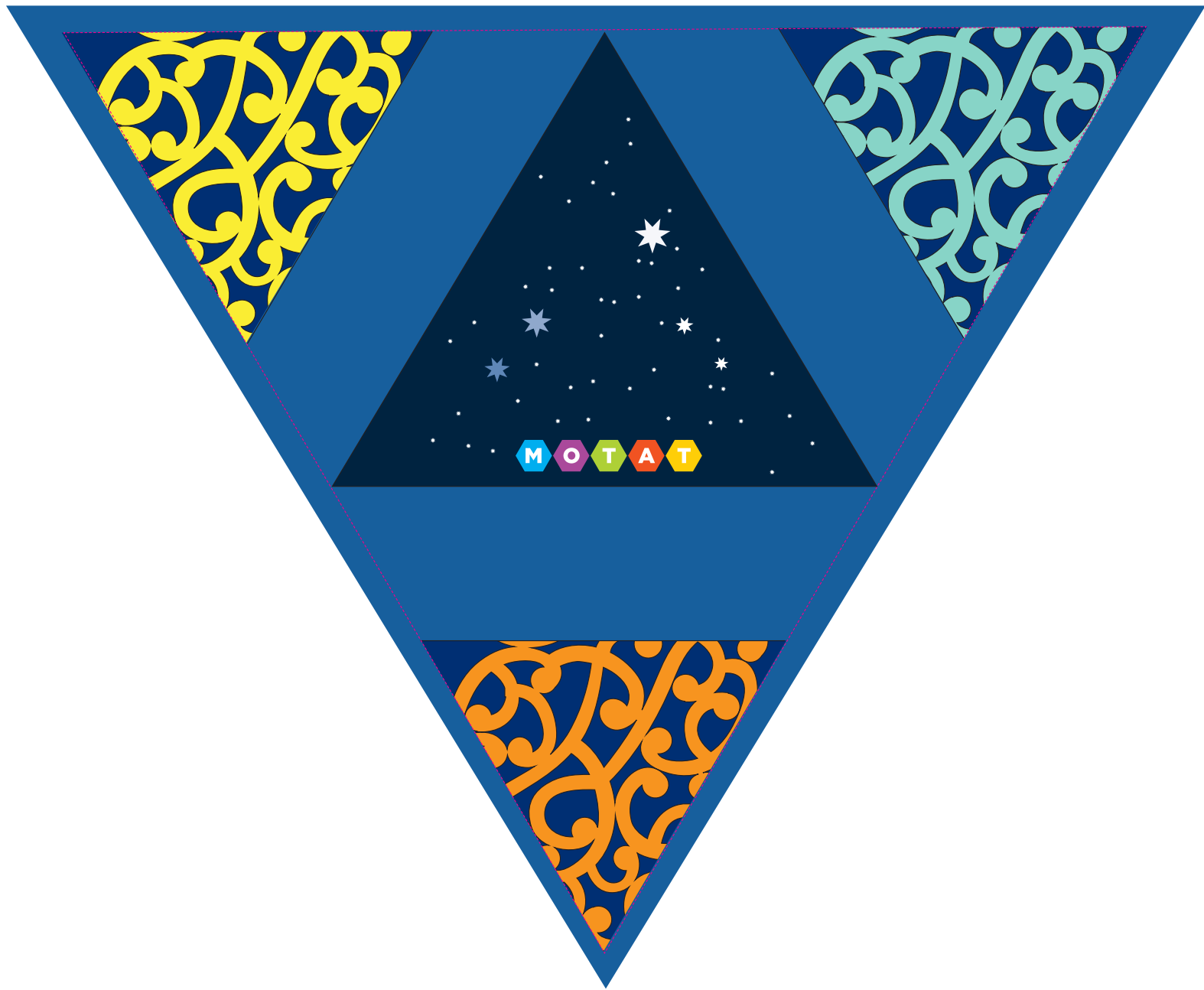
Matariki symbolises the coming of the Māori New Year.
